(Test Site): Traveling North on I-75 Take Exit 134

- To Enter South Gate: Turn right at end of the exit ramp
Take first left onto Fairgrounds

Exit 135

- To Enter West Gate: Turn right at end of exit ramp
Turn right at first traffic light. West Gate entrance on left
- To Enter North Gate: Turn right at end of exit ramp
Proceed straight through traffic light. North Gate entrance on right
- To Enter East Gate: Turn right at end of exit ramp. Proceed straight
through traffic light Proceed to the North Gate entrance

Traveling South on I-75 TAKE Exit 135

- To Enter West Gate: Turn left at end of exit ramp
Turn right at first traffic light. West Gate entrance on left
- To Enter North Gate: Turn left at end of exit ramp
Proceed straight through traffic light. North Gate entrance on right

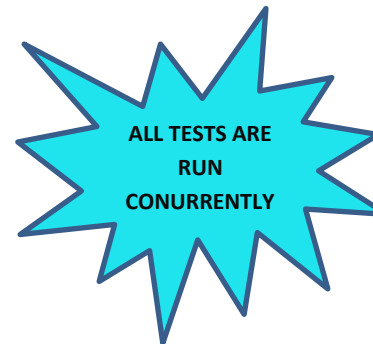

RULES IN THIS NEW NORMAL

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND ADHERE STRICTLY

When this Coronavirus hit, we were all shocked, and eager to find the answer to one question... "When can we resume life as we know it"? While we still do not have a clear answer to that question, we do know that there is a great desire to return to normal and do the things we enjoy, but we must still be careful.

It is in that spirit that the Peach Blossom Cluster Committee, supported by the Officers, Board and Members of the Atlanta Kennel Club, Inc., The Valdosta Kennel Club, Inc. and the Combined Specialty Clubs of Atlanta, have developed the following procedures and practices for our 2022 Cluster of Shows and Events. Everyone who attends the cluster for any event or in any capacity is covered by these "cluster rules" as stated below.

1. If you are sick, do not enter any of the buildings. Go home, and get well.
2. To protect our judges and stewards who must be in close contact with exhibitors and dogs, we require that exhibitors wear masks in the ring. It is up to the judge to let you know if you may lower or remove your mask when gaiting your dog.
3. The cluster will not provide for any seating around rings. Exhibitors can bring their chairs but should maintain social distancing between each other and from the rings. Household units are free to sit together. Chairs may be left in the buildings, if desired, at the risk of the owners.
4. When approaching the rings for showing, only the steward will have access to the ringside catalog and armbands and will look up your number, if necessary, and give you your armband. To facilitate this process, please know what armbands you need. Please maintain a reasonable distance from the table and the person in front of you when securing your armband.
5. Stewards and judges will wear masks (so train your dogs to expect a person in a mask) and judges will have hand sanitizer available between each examination.
6. Exhibits will line up outside the ring maintaining social distancing and exhibits will be called into the ring as each judge deems appropriate. The judge will direct you as to how to prepare your dog for exam. Follow the judge's directions. When gaiting with other exhibits, maintain a distance between exhibits.
7. When attending events other than conformation or obedience, masks are encouraged. There may be additional rules specific to other venues.
8. Depending on State and CDC recommendations at the time of the Shows there may be limitations and or restrictions on the use of blow dryers in the Grooming Building.

The above rules are our attempt to have a fun event and yet still maintain a level of safety for all who attend. We will have committee members circulating to ensure that everyone understands the rules and to answer questions. We ask that you honor any request made of you. Thank You for coming to our show and we look forward to enjoying the Peach!

If CDC guidance changes, updated rules will be posted on peachblossomcluster.org and in the Judging Program.

Any person entering the premises waives all civil liability against this premises owner and operator for any injuries caused by the inherent risk associated with contracting COVID-19 at public gatherings, except for gross negligence, willful and wanton misconduct, reckless infliction of harm, or intentional infliction of harm, by the individual or entity of the premises.

FIELD CONDITIONS

FIELD

The CAT field will be fully fenced with mesh fencing and will have gates at the entrance and exit.



Please bring your own shade and water.

Level parking is very close to the field.

Continuous loop lure machines will be used.

The lure will consist of plastic strips

Only authorized personnel will be permitted near the lure operators tent.

Dogs must remain on leash unless they are running on the track.

For CAT - Dogs are not permitted to run in choke collars (including limited slip martingales) , harnesses, E-Collars or prong collars.

You CAN bring your dogs to the line in a choke, limited slip or harness

E-Collars and Prong collars are not allowed on AKC grounds.

GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

This event is open to all dogs at least one year of age by the day of the event. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers, and dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. A dog may enter only one time per event. Each event has an individual event number. There are two events each day. Events are run **CONCURRENTLY** – meaning the option to run both events in the same time block is allowed.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Breed should be marked as "All American Dog." All American dogs without an Canine Partner number **MAY** register for the AKC Canine Partner program at the field and run for qualifying points

Entry fee is \$22.00 per dog per event. Entries close at the Event Secretary's address **Wednesday, 8:00 pm, March 30, 2022**, unless the numerical limit is reached prior to the date after which time entries will not be accepted.

When entries open, go to the GANG website and click on the "Online Entry" link. Fill out the form. You may pay with a check (just mail the check no need to fill out and send the paper form – see check instructions under Paper Entry Information) or you may pay with credit card using PayPal.

Credit Card Entry fee is \$23.00 per dog per event. Online Entries close Wednesday, 8:00 pm, March 30, 2022, unless the numerical limit is reached prior to the date after which time entries will not be accepted.

HEY HUMANS!!

Us dogs do not have thumbs SO... YOU are responsible for the accuracy of the information required on the entry form. Incomplete entries will NOT receive a run time sign up link until the Event Secretary receives all required information. Changes, additions, or corrections to an entry, entry substitutions, or cancellations must be received by email by the Event Secretary prior to the closing date of the trial. Other means of notification will not be accepted.

Event Information

Field hours are 7:30 am until 5 pm each day EXCEPT SUNDAY. **The field will shut down at 3 pm on Sunday**

Roll Call (Inspection) and Run Order

FOR THESE EVENTS WE WILL BE HOLDING A "ROLLING ROLL CALL"

Inspection begins 15 minutes before your scheduled Time Block. We inspect the dogs as they arrive at the field. You will receive a Run Ticket when you arrive at the field. Take your Run Ticket to the Roll Call area. Dogs must be checked in and inspected prior to **EACH** run. Inspection will check for general fitness and for females in season. Females in season and lame dogs are not permitted to run. Dog's Height will be verified at inspection.

Once your dog has passed inspection, bring your Run Ticket to the Paddock Master Table. You will then be put in the run order.

If you have a 2nd run in the same Time Block you must come back and pick up your Run 2 ticket, be re-inspected and be put on the run order list. If you have a 2nd run in another Time Block – please come back then.

We will do our best to work around conflicts.

Time Blocks

We will be using the "block schedule" running order. A link for YOU to pick your time block will be emailed to you shortly after closing.

Concurrent Run Scheduling

We run events CONCURRENTLY. This means you can schedule your runs in the same Time Block (if there is room), different Time Blocks but in the morning, both runs in the afternoon or a run in the morning and a run in the afternoon. The choice is yours.

Electronic sign-up

We are using SignUp Genius to schedule runs. A link will be emailed to you AFTER entries close.

- 1) Make sure you only sign up for the number of runs per day that you entered!
- 2) There are FIVE (5) Tabs. One for each day. You need to make sure you click on EACH tab for the days you entered and sign up for a time slot 3) We are limiting the number of people at the field at one time.
- 4) We are running CONCURRENT events. What this means is that you can run, rest your dog and then run again within the same time block (you would sign up for 2 runs per dog)
- 5) Make sure you go to the BOTTOM of each days page when you are done and SUBMIT
- 6) There are some time slots already filled - those would be the wonderful volunteers that are there to help make sure we all have a good time and do it safely.
- 7) If you have any questions about getting your dog signed up - email us gangcoursing@gmail.com
- 8) When a block is full, runs cannot be added.
- 9) **This is for those of you who PRE-entered and paid. This is not for Fun Runs or those people that are doing day of entries.**
- 10) **Pre-Entered dogs without a Time Block, On site entries and Fun Runs will all be assigned a Time Block at the field.**

Conditions of Entry – Read Carefully

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.

- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered. Or enter online (EASIER!!)
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, and the “Agreement” found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be refused entry and, if presented at inspection, will be refunded entry fees.
- Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog’s physical strength.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog’s entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- Continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.

Conditions of Entry Continued – Read Carefully

- Any decisions made by the event’s officiating judge(s) regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the judge(s) to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Judge(s) is responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, Peach Blossom Cluster, Speed Dog Coursing, assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event
- There will be portable restroom facilities located near the field. Bring your own shade. No littering.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.

Official Fast CAT Photographer

ML Baer Photography is the official photographer for these events. No other photographer will be allowed to photograph dogs/people without the express consent of ML Baer Photography and the Trial Chairman. Anyone caught photographing these events, or any portion thereof, without permission will be asked to leave the field. An AKC Event Committee hearing may also be called if unsportsmanlike behavior is evident.
